

CAMPSITES

- **Arrival 5:00 pm / Departure 1:00 pm**
Although guests are welcome to remain in the general campground longer, personal campsites should be packed and cleared by 1:00 pm. If you arrive before 5:00 pm your site may not be ready for immediate occupancy but you are welcome to explore the campground and play games.
- Camping gear rentals are available; gear should be reserved in advance through the reservations office at 800-400-7238. Please see Rentals Chart for further information.
- Campsites assigned by staff according to total camping reservations. Assignments are posted near trip check-in which is located in front of the camp store at the right end of the parking lot.
- Campfires are prohibited by the Forest Service most of the season.
- *Open-fire barbecues are NOT permitted most of the season due to mandated fire restrictions. **We recommend bringing only propane cooking equipment.***

FACILITIES

- **Electricity:** Limited; campground is very dark in campsites and on trails. Please bring flashlights.
- **Restroom:** Small but nice with separate rooms for men and women, each with two flush toilets and three showers. Continually maintained by our Camp Host but impossible to keep clean without the help of guests...shower area floor tends to flood...we keep a supply of floor towels in the shower area that guests are welcome to use to keep the floor dry and safe. There is also a four-station outdoor sink area next to the restroom. We do ask that guests refrain from washing dishes in sinks.
- **For Kids:** Games (including two pool tables, giant-size chess, foosball, volleyball), nature hike, and lots of fun!
- **Camp Store:** Sunscreen, water shoes, sunglasses, sunglass straps, flashlights, water cameras, beach towels, ice, beverages, snacks, tee-shirts and hats are available for purchase. Store is open at trip check-in time and from 4:00-7:00 pm.
- **Pets:** We love pets but, regretfully, they are not allowed in the campground for the health and safety of all guests—as well as for the sake of the animal that might be locked in a vehicle or leashed to a tree while their guardian is on the river. DIRECTIONS

From Bay Area

1. Highway 80 East towards Sacramento.
2. Approaching Sacramento, Highway 80 splits...80 Reno/50 Tahoe...take 50 towards Tahoe.
3. From the initial 80/50 split, you will travel approximately 40 miles further on the freeway.
4. Exit on Ponderosa Road / Exit 37 (after Cameron Park but before Placerville).
5. At exit stoplight turn left onto the overpass and cross over freeway.
6. At the end of the overpass, at the 2nd stoplight (the 2nd light is only a tiny distance from the 1st light), turn right onto North Shingle Springs Road.
7. After approximately five miles, North Shingle Springs Road curves left and becomes "Lotus Road."
8. Continue on Lotus Road approximately six more miles—following signs toward Coloma / Lotus.
9. Lotus Road will end at Highway 49 (a 3-way stop sign)—turn left onto Highway 49.
10. Almost immediately after turning onto Highway 49 you will cross over the river.
11. After crossing the river, you will see "River Park Village" (small shopping center on the left). Turn left into River Park Village...there are two entrances into the shopping center; the safest entrance is the second one which provides a left turn lane. Turn into the center at the second entrance then immediately curve left then right...you will see the entrance to our campground straight ahead.

From South Lake Tahoe

- A. Highway 50 West.
- B. When going through Placerville on 50, hook onto Highway 49 (a right turn at signal light for "Spring Street").
- C. Follow 49 about 20 miles...when you pass Lotus Rd. on your left you are entering Coloma (the Sierra Nevada House Restaurant is on the left on the corner of 49 and Lotus Rd.) After you pass Lotus Road on the left you will almost immediately cross over the river...then follow step 11 above.
